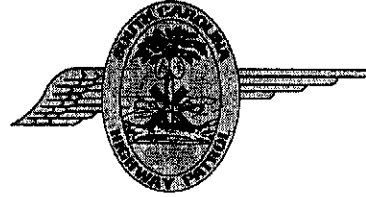

Provided through a partnership with SLED, SCDNR and SCDPPPS, our chaplains are available to provide assistance with a variety of professional and personal needs. Governed by SCDPS Policy 200.23, the chaplains are available to SCDPS employees 24 hours/day.

Sample of Services Provided Through SCLEAP/Chaplaincy Program

- Provide Pastoral Care to DPS employees and their families
- Visit Sick and Injured Staff/Family members in the Hospital
- Serve as Liaison with Clergy in the Statewide Religious Community
- Assist in Weddings and Funerals
- Assist in Public Ceremonies such as Graduations, Award Ceremonies, Swearing In Ceremonies, Service of Remembrance
- In Partnership with SCDPS Staff, maintain the SCDPS Peer Support Team (includes: recruiting, training and deployment of peers following critical incidents)
- Provide a system of assistance and referral for matters related to Mental Health
- Provide a system of peer support and referral for matters related to Addiction
- Provide a system of assistance and referral for Marriage and Family Issues
- Provide a system of assistance and referral for Post Deployment Issues
- Provide for Access to Post Critical Incident Seminar Programs
- Assist with Death Notifications for Employee Deaths as Requested
